It is to be understood that these offers are made without commitment and on the assumption that satisfactory offers will be made in return. In certain cases New Zealand tariff rates have been reduced at the expense of countries receiving preferential treatment. In these cases it is also understood that the reductions proposed to be made by New Zealand are subject to satisfactory agreement respecting reciprocal concessions to such countries.



Following upon the termination of the bilateral stage of tariff negotiations between New Zealand and Norway I am attaching a copy of the list of tariff concessions offered by New Zealand to Norway, on which provisional agreement was reached by the New Zealand and Norwegian tariff negotiating teams.

It is to be understood that such concessions are subject to any adjustment that may be required as a result of negotiations, as they are completed, with other countries at Geneva. They are also subject to approval of the Government of New Zealand. Before the General Agreement embodying the concessions can be made effective, it must be ratified by the New Zealand Parliament.
