It has been drawn up in accordance with South Africa's often-stated intention of participating in the tariff negotiations on an item-by-item basis.

The initial rate of duty is the bound rate of duty except in two instances where the present applied rate of duty is shown. In a number of cases, indicated by a footnote, where there is no concession in Part I of Schedule XVIII - South Africa, the preferential rate of duty bound in Part II is shown.

The offer is subject to review in the light of developments in the negotiations.
