Sir,

On instructions of my Government I have hereby the honour to inform you as follows:

- 1. Iceland's offer in the tariff field of the Multilateral Trade Negotiations will comprise the following:
 - a) Annual m.f.n. tariff reductions implemented since the beginning of the Tokyo Round in 1973.
 - b) M.f.n. tariff reductions scheduled by law to be implemented on January 1, 1979 and January 1, 1980.
- 2. It is estimated that the above reductions will amount to an average lowering of tariffs by 20.1%. As a result of these tariff reductions, government revenue from customs collections will be reduced by approximately 21.4% from 1973 to 1980.
- 3. Furthermore, protective tariffs on industrial goods originating in the EFTA countries and the European Economic Community will be totally abolished on January 1, 1980, in accordance with the timetable agreed upon when Iceland joined EFTA in 1970 and the subsequent free trade agreement with the EEC of July 22, 1972.

Based on 1973 imports, it is estimated that government revenue from customs collections will be reduced by 42% on account of the overall tariff reductions during the period 1973 - 1980.

- 4. The new Customs Tariff, which was approved by Parliament on May 6, 1978, is being published and will be made available to interested delegations.
- 5. Further explanations of Iceland's tariff reductions referred to above are annexed to this letter.
- 6. Copies of the Icelandic Customs Tariffs of 1973 and 1977 are available for inspection in the GATT Secretariat and at the Icelandic Permanent Mission.

I should be obliged if you would arrange for the distribution of this letter and its annexes to all participants in the MTN.

Tariff reductions 1973 - 1980

Since the Multilateral Trade Negotiations started in 1973 the Icelandic Customs Tariff has undergone two major revisions, the first by Law No. 6 of March 5, 1974 and the second by Law No. 120 of December 31, 1976. The new Customs Tariff Law which was enacted in May 1978 does not provide for any major tariff amendments but includes recent CCCN changes.

A) Customs Tariff Law of 1974

The Customs Tariff Law of 1974 provided for the following major tariff reductions to enter into force from 1974 to 1976:

- 1. Protective tariffs on m.f.n. basis were reduced annually parallel to the contractual tariff reductions on EFTA/EEC originating products, in accordance with the attached schedule No. 1.
- 2. Revenue duties on certain raw materials for domestic industries were reduced to zero in two equal steps, the first on March 22, 1974 and the second on January 1, 1976.
- 3. Revenue duties on certain kinds of industrial machinery in chapters 84 and 85 were reduced to zero.
- 4. Revenue duties on products such as dried fruit, spices, canned vegetables, tableware and household utensils were reduced by 20 percentage points.

B) Customs Tariff Law of 1976

This Law became effective as of January 1, 1977 and stipulates the reductions of m.f.n. rates of duty and EFTA/EEC preferential rates of duties to take place in 1977, 1978, 1979 and 1980.

The major tariff reductions in this period are as follows:

- 1. Protective tariffs on m.f.n. basis continue to be reduced annually parallel to the contractual tariff reductions on EFTA/EEC originating products, in accordance with the attached schedule No. 2.
- 2. The scope of raw materials for industrial production eligible for tariff reductions (cf. item A2 above) is further expanded. In some instances (mainly in chapters 51-61) the tariff reductions are accelerated as compared to the preceeding period (1974-1976).
- 3. The reductions of revenue duties expressed under item A3 above are continued and the scope for machinery as well as parts and tools is expanded and now also covers chapters 82 and 86-90. Duties in this connection are either reduced to zero already in 1977 or gradually to zero during the period 1977-1980.
- 4. Revenue duties on various building materials (mainly chapters 39, 44, 48, 68, 69, 70, 73-76 and 85) generally carrying a duty of 18-35% were reduced either to zero already in 1977 or gradually to zero during the period 1977-1980.
- 5. The highest duty rate is reduced in two steps by 20% for all goods, the first step as from 1978 and the second as from 1980.

- 1. The offered concession rates represent the rates at the final stage of implementation.
- 2. On the understanding that the tariff reductions offered by other contracting parties will be implemented over a period of eight years and will start on 1 January 1980, the full concessions offered by Iceland will be applied as of 1 January 1980. Should, however, other participants withold, withdraw or defer the implementation of concessions for certain items, Iceland reserves its rights to act accordingly.
