CONCESSIONS IN ASPECT OF REQUESTS MADE BY NORWAY ON THE UNITED KINGDOM TARIFF

Notes. 1. In view of the possibility that during the currency of the present tariff concessions the United Kingdom may adopt the common Tariff Nomenclature recently prepared at Brussels, the following concessions are expressed in alternative versions. The wording in column 3 represents the concession based on the existing United Kingdom Tariff. The wording in column 4 represents the concession expressed in terms of the Brussels Nomenclature. The former definition is valid unless and until the United Kingdom brings into force a Tariff based on the Brussels Nomenclature Convention; thereafter the latter definition only would be valid.

2. The concession on grinding wheels refers to the duty chargeable under Part 3 of the United Kingdom Tariff. The concession on dicyandiamide refers to the duty chargeable under Part 5 of the Tariff, but also precludes any higher charge under Part 3 of the Tariff.
