■ When ?

Table ES:1 : annually

- Members with base and annual commitment levels shown in Section II of Part IV of their Schedule No later than 60 days following the end of the calendar/marketing/fiscal year in question. When the notification is provisional, a final one to be submitted no later than 120 days following the end of the year.
- Members with no base and annual commitment levels No later than 30 days following the end of the calendar/marketing/fiscal year in question

Tables ES:2 and ES:3 : annually

No later than 120 days following the end of the calendar/marketing/fiscal year in question

Members with scheduled ES commitments

- ES provided in quantity and outlay terms for all scheduled products
- Quantity of food aid provided (column 5 of Table ES:1)
- Application of Article 9.4 ES by developing country Members

ST/ES:1

- ES provided as per the sub-categories listed in Article 9.1

ST/ES:2

- ES provided by developing country Members as per Article 9.1(d) and (e)

- ✓ Description of products listed in Section II of Part IV of the Member's Schedule
- ✓ Start of the reporting period, if different from calendar year (from Section II, Part IV)
- ✓ Outlay and quantity of commitment levels per product (from Section II, Part IV)
- ✓ Outlay and quantity of subsidised exports for all products listed in Section II, Part IV
- ✓ Quantity of food aid provided for products subject to scheduled reduction commitments
- ✓ Outlay of:
 - direct export subsidies;
 - sales of stocks;
 - producer financed subsidies;
 - cost reduction measures;
 - internal transport subsidies

- ✓ Description and volume of exports for each of the products subject to reduction commitments or in respect of which the respective Member has been designated as “Significant exporter”
