Paragraphs 1 to 10 inclusive were approved without comment.

Annex 2

Mr. NASH (New Zealand) supported by the representative of Mexico, expressed the view that the word "international" had a wider connotation and significance than the word "inter-governmental" and should have been maintained in the first sentence of paragraph 1 of Article 7.

To meet the views of the New Zealand representative, Miss FISHER (United Kingdom) suggested that a sentence could be added to the Report to the effect that some representatives would have preferred the word "international" because of its wider connotation.

After a short discussion, it was agreed to include a sentence along the lines suggested by the United Kingdom representative in Annex 2, with reference to Article 7.
