SUB-COMMITTEE J ON ARTICLES 95, 96, 98, 99 AND 100

NEW ZEALAND: PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 68(5)

The Chairman of the Sixth Committee, considering that the proposal of the delegation of New Zealand in regard to paragraph 5 of Article 68 is concerned with substantially the same matters as the proposal of the delegation of the United States regarding the application of the Charter to Germany and Japan, has requested that Sub-Committee J take this proposal into consideration. The text of paragraph 5 of Article 68 as proposed by the delegation of New Zealand is as follows:

"5. The Conference shall, upon application by the competent authorities, determine, by a two-thirds majority of the votes cast, the conditions upon which, in each individual case, membership rights and obligations shall be extended to:

- (a) the Free Territory of Trieste;
- (b) any Trust Territory administered by the United Nations; and
- (c) any other special regime established by the United Nations; and
- (d) any other special regime in which two or more countries are concerned as parties to an intergovernmental agreement whether or not all countries party to such agreement are actively engaged in the administration of the regime.
