Replace the statement of Mr. ONYIA by the following:

"Mr. ONYIA (Nigeria) referred to Annex II, page 9, of document L/2276 and noted that the statistics relating to trade with Nigeria showed that Poland had suffered an adverse balance of trade with Nigeria in 1963 whereas the Nigerian statistics showed quite a different picture with an adverse balance of trade with Poland in 1963. He hoped that it would be possible for both the Polish and Nigerian delegations to look into the cause of the discrepancy in their statistics. He also said that many factors were responsible for the present pattern of trade between the two countries. His country, he added, was still not very experienced in dealing with the trading system involved."
