## PROCEDURES FOR COMPLETION OF BILATERAL NEGOTIATIONS

Note was taken by the Tariff Negotiations Committee of the procedures suggested by the secretariat for the completion of bilateral negotiations. These procedures are set out hereunder.

Upon completion of a bilateral negotiation forty copies (numbered and marked SECRET) of the two lists of concessions exchanged by the parties should be addressed to the secretariat. They should be accompanied by a letter on the lines of the following model.

The secretariat will distribute these lists to all members of the Tariff Negotiations Committee. If one of the parties to a bilateral agreement has not exchanged its consolidated offers list with a delegation with which negotiations are contemplated, it may ask that the distribution of its bilateral list to that delegation be delayed until the question of negotiations has been settled.

The attention of delegations is called to the target date of 31 March for the completion of bilateral negotiations.
