#### Explanatory Note

This table is based on export data (in f.o.b. terms) derived from estimates of the United Nations Statistical Office. In the United Nations estimates for trade among less-developed countries, certain entrepôt trade (which is particularly important in South-East Asia) and shipments of crude petroleum for refining and subsequent exports to other areas are not excluded. In order to eliminate the more important elements of double counting, an attempt has been made to calculate "adjusted" figures by deducting:

- (i) re-exports from Hong Kong and exports from Singapore to other countries in South-East Asia, and
- (ii) shipments of rubber and of crude petroleum to other less-developed countries for processing and subsequent export.

In this calculation, figures for the re-exports and rubber shipments are obtained from national trade returns and, in respect of petroleum, are derived from production, trade and consumption data contained in World Energy Supplies (United Nations Statistical Papers, Series J, No. 7). With regard to certain manufactured goods, in particular machinery and transport equipment, it has not been possible to ascertain the size of exports of domestically produced goods and the intra-trade figures may include shipments of used machinery produced outside the region as well as a significant amount of re-exports.
