ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Report on Status of Restrictive Measures under
Article 2, paragraphs 1 and 4

Note by the Chairman

The TSB has received from the Government of Portugal, on behalf of Macao, a report on restrictive measures maintained by Macao on trade in textiles. The TSB has examined the report and has found that it is in conformity with the Arrangement.

The TSB is circulating this notification to participating countries for information.

In accordance with what we had agreed upon on 9 October, I have the honour to inform you of the following:

- (a) Macao applies no quantitative restrictions to imports of textile products. Thus, these imports are absolutely free. Neither do we apply any restriction of a unilateral nature.

We have auto-restriction agreements on our exports of textile products with the United States, Norway, Sweden, Canada and Australia. We have just signed the preliminaries to a similar agreement with the EEC.
