Communication from the European Economic Community

The Executive Secretary has received the following communication, dated 12 June 1964, from the Commission of the Furopean Economic Community:

"I have the honour to inform you that the Council of the European Economic Community has determined the common customs tariff duties applicable to certain petroleum products as indicated in the Annex hereto.

"The Community is ready to open tariff negotiations for the purpose of replacing by concessions in the common customs tariff the concessions formerly granted by the member itates on petroleum products for which no compensation was given during the 1960-1961 Tariff Conference.

"I should be glad if you would bring the present communication to the attention of the contracting parties."

Contracting parties wishing to enter into negotiations with the European Economic Community are requested to approach the Commission of the European Economic Community and at the same time to inform the Executive Secretary.
