FRANCO-GERMAN TREATY ON THE SAAR

Seventh Annual Reports (1964) Submitted by France and the Federal Republic of Germany

Under paragraph 5 of the Decision of 22 November 1957 (BISD 68/30) the Governments of France and the Federal Republic of Germany are required to submit annual reports on measures taken by them in terms of the Decision. The following information relating to the special measures instituted in their trade relations with the Saar in 1963 has been furnished by the two governments.

In 1963, these measures consisted in the reciprocal granting of tariff quotas, based on trade in 1955, permitting duty-free imports of French goods into the Saar (List A) and duty-free imports of goods from the Saar into France (List B).

The value of French goods imported into the Saar under List A in 1963 amounted to DM 950 million, representing a utilization of about 63 per cent of the total amount of the quotas. During the same year goods from the Saar were imported into France under List B to a value of F 618 million, representing a utilization of about 63 per cent of the quotas.
