9. ITALY

(A) List of Residual Restrictions on Imports from
Contracting Parties to GATT

1. The residual restrictions included in this list apply to all contracting parties. For State-trading countries and Japan special lists are in effect.
2. The restrictions on the importation of semi-manufactured gold and articles of gold are applied in conformity with Article XX, paragraph (c) of the General Agreement.
3. The restrictions on the importation of common salt (including rock salt, sea salt, and table salt), pure sodium chloride and tobacco are applied in virtue of legislation enacted prior to the Protocol of Annecy and are covered by the provisions of paragraph 1 (a) (ii) of the said Protocol.
