DANISH IMPORT RESTRICTIONS

Liberalization Effective 1 January 1965

The Danish Government has advised that as from 1 January 1965 the Danish liberalization of imports from countries within the Danish free-list area has been further extended to include the items listed below.¹

<u>BTN No.</u>	<u>Commodity Description</u>
<u>Food and feeding stuffs</u>	
ex 29.43	Invert sugar, fructose and maltose, chemically pure (rest of item)
<u>Manufactured goods</u>	
ex 40.06	Adhesives on backings of plastics or paper (rest of item)
ex 48.07	Carbon paper and tracing paper in rolls or sheets (rest of item)
ex 48.13	Carbon and other copying papers and transfer papers, cut to size whether or not put up in boxes (rest of item)
ex 62.03	Sacks and bags, of a kind used for the packing of goods (rest of item)
ex 84.16	Ironing machines and parts thereof (rest of item)
ex 84.18	Centrifugal driers and parts thereof (rest of item)
ex 84.40	Ironing machines, wringers, steam presses and mangles, for domestic use or for laundries and parts of such machinery
ex 84.61	Taps, cocks, valves and similar appliances, for pipes, boiler shells, tanks, vats and the like, including pressure reducing valves and thermostatically controlled valves, weighing 3 kgs. or less (rest of item)
