"Since the attitude taken by the Working Party was largely a recognition of the desirability of meeting the needs of less-developed countries, any special treatment in the reduction and removal of the surcharges limited to products of interest to less-developed countries which the United Kingdom might feel able to give in the light of the views expressed in the Working Farty should not be considered by the United Kingdom's other trading partners as creating a justification for them to press for special treatment for their own trade."
