SECOND CERTIFICATION OF CHANGES TO SCHEDULES

Schedule XLII - Israel

The following communication has been received from the permanent representative of Israel.

I have the honour to inform you that my authorities have compiled a draft consolidated Schedule XLII - Israel.

This new draft consolidates the original Schedule XLII¹, the Kennedy Round concessions and the changes resulting from our recently completed Article XXVIII renegotiations.²

While the draft consolidated schedule continues to follow the Brussels Tariff Nomenclature, the enumeration of sub-items has been amended in order to bring it into line with the current Israel Customs Tariff. For the convenience of contracting parties, a concordance has been appended giving cross references from the existing schedule to the draft consolidated schedule.

My Government requests that the present draft be formally established, through the certification procedure, as the new Schedule XLII - Israel.

Two copies of the draft consolidated schedule - including a list of corrections - and the concordance attached thereto are being sent to each contracting party.

If no objections are notified to the secretariat within sixty days from the date of this document, the draft Schedule XLII - Israel will be considered to have been approved and will be incorporated in the Second Certification of Changes to Schedules.
