ARTICLE XIX ACTION BY CANADA

Import Quotas on Cattle, Beef and Veal

Addendum

The following communication, dated 19 January 1976, has been received from the Canadian delegation.

---

On 2 August 1974 the Canadian Government announced import quotas on live cattle for slaughter and fresh and frozen beef and veal, which were to take effect on 12 August 1974. The Contracting Parties were informed of this action on 12 August, which was reported in documents L/4072 dated 19 August 1974 and L/4072/Add.1 dated 26 September 1974.

The Canadian Government wishes to inform the Contracting Parties that effective 1 January, imports into Canada from any country except Rhodesia of beef and veal in fresh and frozen form will no longer require individual import licences but will be allowed entry into Canada under open general licence. This action terminates Canadian border measures in regard to live cattle and beef and veal taken pursuant to the provisions of Article XIX.
