Schedule XXX - Sweden

Addendum

In 1978 Sweden accepted the International Convention on Tonnage Measurement of Ships, 1969. The deposit of the instrument of ratification with the IMCO was effected in May 1979.

With reference to the draft consolidated loose-leaf Schedule XXX - Sweden and taking into account that the convention mentioned above shall come into force on 18 July 1982, the description of products relating to two tariff items of the schedule should be revised as follows:
