Schedule V - Canada

The following communication, dated<sup>1</sup> 24 March 1982, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Canada.

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As a result of the termination by the United States of its import relief action on certain iron or steel fasteners, Canada is obligated, under its Tokyo Round commitments, to implement tariff concessions on similar fasteners. Order-in-Council PC 1982-775 of 11 March 1982 provides that Canadian tariff rates on fasteners are to be reduced according to the attached schedule.
