## PROTOCOL REGARDING MILK FAT

### Communication from the Australian Permanent Mission

The following communication, dated 6 January 1986, has been received from the Australian Permanent Mission.

#### Reporting of Shipments of Sales of Butter made under the Safeguard Provisions of the Resolution of 16 November 1984 (DPC/13)

In addition to shipments through to May 1985 which have already been reported in DPC/W/50/Rev.2 the following shipments have been made through to December 1985:
