ACCESSION OF MEXICO TO THE MTN AGREEMENTS

Communication from Mexico

The following letter has been received on 23 February 1987 by the Director-General from Mr. Hector Hernandez Cervantes, Secretary for Trade and Industrial Development of Mexico.

I have pleasure in writing to confirm Mexico's undertaking to sign the Agreements known as the Anti-Dumping Code; Customs Valuation Code; Code on Technical Barriers to Trade; and Code on Import Licensing Procedures, as mentioned in paragraph 68 of document L/6010 - report of the Working Party on the Accession of Mexico to the GATT.

In view of the fact that the signature of these Codes will constitute the first formal act by the Mexican Government after having succeeded to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, I wish to inform you that I shall personally sign the corresponding instruments. For this purpose, I shall be travelling to Geneva, Switzerland in the course of May next and shall take the opportunity of being in Geneva to participate in the meeting of the Council of Representatives scheduled for that period.
