Corrigendum

Paragraph 6, under section B(ii) on page 2, should be amended to read as follows:

"6. The representative of Mexico said that Mexican legislation on customs matters was applied and governed by the Customs Law and its Regulations, which had been published in the Official Journal of the Federation and entered into force on 10 July 1982. The Customs Law and its Regulations currently in force superseded the Customs Code, the Customs Valuation Law and the Law establishing the frontier customs guard service. The section concerning customs valuation in Mexico was contained in the Customs Law, chapter 3, taxable base, articles 48 to 55 and in its Regulations, chapter 3, taxable base, articles 117 to 132."
