ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Notification under Article 4

Modification of the Bilateral Agreement Between the EEC and Pakistan

The Textiles Surveillance Body received a notification from the EEC of a further modification of its bilateral agreement with Pakistan resulting from the implementation of the Harmonized System.¹

The TSB, pursuant to its procedures regarding notifications made under Article 4,² has examined the relevant documentation and is transmitting the text of the notification to participating countries for their information.³

AGREED MINUTE

1. In furtherance of the consultations held on 14-4-1988, in accordance with Article 16 of the Bilateral Agreement on Trade in Textiles between Pakistan and the European Community, the delegations of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan and the European Community, met in Islamabad on 19/20 April, 1989 for adjustment of restraint level of Category 4 due to transfer of certain NIMEX positions of Category 83 to Category 4 as a consequence of introduction of Harmonized System.

2. It was agreed that Pakistan was entitled for compensation on this account. Considering the total trade flow of 1986 of those NIMEX positions transferred from Category 83 to Category 4 it was agreed that the annual limits for importation into the European Community from Pakistan for Category 4 shall be as follows:

1989	-	14,494,000 Pcs
1990	-	15,173,000 Pcs
1991	-	15,886,000 Pcs

In agreeing the above limits the trade loss to Pakistan in 1987 and 1988 has also been taken into consideration.

3. The annual limits to be allocated among members States are as follows:
