Note from the Delegation of Switzerland

The delegation of Switzerland has submitted the following by letter dated 5 October 1983.

1. Contents

The guide would essentially consist of chapters by countries. However, a brief summary of the objectives and principles of the Agreement might be added by way of introduction.

2. Form

The secretariat has already published and put on sale Annexes I-IV to the Agreement in loose-leaf form. It would seem advisable to adopt the same system for this practical guide. It could be published and sold in the three languages of GATT.

3. Preparation of the guide

As soon as the Committee takes a decision on its contents, the secretariat could prepare a draft guide, which could then be supplemented by contributions from delegations.
